## FALCON BAND COMMUNICATION

We use a number of methods of communication to get information and reminders to families and students quickly. Your student may now choose to receive text messages and/or join a closed and monitored Band Facebook group to get Band information quickly. We will continue to send information and updates via Band Booster email messages as well.

Starting the day after the current school ends, we will begin to send text messages and Facebook updates as needed for the summer and the upcoming school year. **Parents and students must complete and return the attached CFSD Use of Technology Resources form to their band director during the finals period for your student to participate.**

Here are the options for communication:

- **Band Facebook Page:** Your student may request to be a member of the "Foothills Falcon Band 2018-19" Facebook page. They will not be Facebook friends with any of the teachers by doing this, and it is a closed group, available only to admin-approved students. Students can join the page by emailing their section leader to request membership. Student section leaders will be contacting each member of their section early this summer, so you will have their contact information. (This does not apply to jazz groups and small ensembles.) Make sure to complete the summer contact information on Form A to make sure your student receives communications from the student leaders.
- **Group Text Messages – Remind:** Your student can receive group texts from Ms. Shane-Boyd through Remind. She will not be able to see your student's phone number, and students will not be able to see hers, but they can receive immediate information regarding the program. They can join after **May 20** by texting the appropriate code for their group to this number: **81010**. Students from last year will need to re-register after May 20, because this year's groups will be deleted on that day.

**Explanation of Fees.** There are two types of fees that Band students pay in July and August:

**Band Booster fees:** These are for supplies (gloves, shoes, etc.), and are paid directly to our Band Booster group, and you will pay these at Band Camp Sendoff. For more information about these fees, see Form C of this Summer Packet.

**District Fees for Fine Arts classes:** The appropriate fees below must be paid along with all other school fees on the District InTouch system during CFHS online check-in in August. For your information in advance, the fees will be:

**BAND CO-CURRICULAR FEE (\$25)** This fee is for all school activities with an extra-curricular component. You will pay this fee if you are in Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, Beginning, Intermediate, or Advanced steel, Drumline, Jazz Band, Jazz Combo, Colorguard, Flute Choir, or Clarinet Choir.

**BAND TRAVEL FEE (\$55)** Pay this fee if you are in Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band, Jazz Combo, Colorguard.

**STEEL TRAVEL FEE (\$55)** Pay this fee if you are in Intermediate or Advanced Steel Drum.

**UNIFORM FEE (\$35)** All members of Marching Band, Drumline (cymbals, battery, pit), and Colorguard pay this fee.

**PERCUSSION FEE (\$75)** All percussionists (except Steel), including cymbals, pit & battery, must pay this fee.

**STEEL DRUM TUNING FEES (\$15 Beginning Steel, one semester only; \$25 Beginning Steel whole year, Intermediate Steel, Advanced Steel)**

**INSTRUMENT FEE (\$95 for use of school-owned sousaphone, bari sax, baritone, bass clarinet, piccolo, trombone, mellophone)**

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## WHY BAND BOOSTERS?

The Catalina Foothills High School (CFHS) Band Booster organization is very proud of our award-winning music program. Our students marched in the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade, at the Fiesta Bowl National Band Championship, and in England, China; Australia; Honolulu and Disneyland, all in the last few years. We have the largest high school marching band in the State of Arizona, with well over 250 instrumental and Colorguard students. We have more than 100 additional students who participate in jazz, concert, steel drum and small ensembles. Our groups have a reputation for excellence, receiving multiple awards each year at local and state-wide competitions.

Did you know that it costs close to \$1000 in bus and truck rentals to transport the CFHS marching band to an in-town competition? It costs about \$500 to place one student in a marching uniform! Add the costs of salaries for teachers and coaches, flags, rifles and accessories, instrument maintenance, music license fees, competition fees, marching show choreography, student leadership and master musician classes, and more, and soon one understands what it takes to sustain a music program of this caliber.

Funding from the Catalina Foothills School District is only able to meet a portion of the CFHS music program's estimated budget.

### How does Band Boosters support the band?

1. **Fundraisers:** Band Booster fundraising activities help cover the difference between what the District is able to contribute and what the band program requires to maintain excellence.
2. **Volunteer Support:** Band Booster parent volunteers fill many roles, from fundraising, chairing committees, baking, sewing, copying, computer work, chaperoning, heavy lifting, feeding the kids, taking pictures, and much more. When you consider volunteering in any capacity, rest assured that there are many seasoned volunteers to help you learn the job.
3. **Band Camp Costs/Student Accounts:** Band Boosters help with Band Camp costs and volunteer events for students who wish to raise funds for their personal student accounts to help pay for travel fees.

### What can I do to support the band?
